GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. Registration is compulsory.
- 2. Kindly fill the Google form for registration. https://forms.gle/U1YVeLMkcpQiHtFk6
- Registration is free for all the participants; Food will be available as per the prior booking with payment of Rs 200/person and upload the screen shot of payment details along with the submission of registration form.
- 4. Last date for registration is 27TH Feb 2025
- 5. All participants are instructed to wear their college ID card compulsorily on the day of event.
- 6. All participants are instructed to follow the scheduled time.
- 7. Each institute may kindly designate one faculty as overall coordinator for the event and can coordinate with Prof Dr Sreemini Pillai for further help.
- 8. From each institution maximum 10 members (including faculty) participation for any 3 events is permitted
- 9. Judges' decision will be final.

Note: Accommodation will be not be available.





SOLO SONG

- ❖ Two entries per college is allowed.
- Only Hindi songs are allowed.
- ❖ Time limit for solo song is 3 minutes.
- Song selection must be decent & verified by the coordinator.
- Mixing of song is allowed.
- Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- ❖ Karaoke/Self-instrument playing is allowed.
- Participants must bring in pen drive/mobile with chord of the track
- No spot entries will be obliged.
- Judge's decision will be final.

GROUP SONG

- One team per college is allowed.
- Each team may have maximum 6 participants.
- Time limit is minimum 4 minutes and maximum 6 minutes for each performance.
- Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- Participants can mix more than one song if required within the prescribed time limit.
- Participants can arrange/bring the prop (if any) with self.
- Costume & song selection must be decent.

SOLO DANCE

- Two entries per college is allowed one for Western and one for Classical.
- The time limit for the participants is minimum 3 minutes and maximum 5 minutes.
- Participants must bring Pen Drive/Mobile with chord of the track on which dance is to be performed.
- Participants can mix more than one song if required within the prescribed time limit.
- Participants can arrange/bring the prop (if any) with self.
- ❖ Costumes & song selection must be decent.
- No spot entries will be obliged.
- Judge's decision will be final.

GROUP DANCE

- One team per college is allowed.
- Each team may have maximum 6 participants.
- Time limit is minimum 4 minutes and maximum 6 minutes for each performance.
- Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- The participants are requested to bring pen drive/mobile with chord of the track on which dance is to be performed.
- Participants can mix more than one song if required within the prescribed time limit.
- Participants can arrange/bring the prop (if any) with self.
- Costume & song selection must be decent.
- Judge's decision will be final.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PLAY

- Bring instrument and related items
- · Maintain good posture and hand positioning.
- Play with confidence and expression.
- Project your voice to reach the audience.
- Participants can arrange/bring the prop (if any) with self.
- Costumes & song selection must be decent.
- No spot entries will be obliged.
- Judge's decision will be final.

SKIT

- The theme of the skit shall be given at the time of event
- The team participating in the skit shall have a minimum of 5 members and a maximum of 8 members.
- Each team will be allowed a maximum of 4 minutes to prepare the stage and 6 minutes to perform.
- The props will be arranged by the teams themselves (General furniture like table/chairs will be made available at event venue).
- No use of slangs and un-parliamentary language in the skit.
- The competition will be judged on the basis of the script, facial expressions, creative use of props, stage mannerism, co-ordination, voice modulation and overall performance.
- Final ratings shall be decided by aggregating points awarded by a panel of judges.
- In case of any dispute, decision of the organizers of the event shall be final and conclusive



POETRY RECITATION

- Theme for poem is 'Climate Change'
- Poem shall be in Hindi.
- Time allotted is 4 minutes.
- A warning bell will be sounded at 3rd minute and a final bell will be at the 4th minute.
- The timekeeper will announce the time taken by each team right after the recitation.
- The poem must be entirely authentic and original and must never have been published prior to this competition.
- Materials presented must not touch on sensitive issues, such as race, religion, stereotyping, politics etc.
- Contestants must not present a commentary of the poem.
- There shall be no inclusion of singing, music, props or artificial sound effects.

BEAUTY PAGEANT

- Two entries per college is allowed one for male and one for female.
- In the first round, wear traditional attire. Contestants will be judged on their physical appearance, including facial beauty, body proportion, and overall attractiveness.
- Wear western attire in second round. Contestants will be judged on their personality, including confidence, charm, and charisma. Special talents can be elicited in this round like including singing, dancing, or playing a musical instrument.

RANGOLI

- Number of entries per college is unlimited.
- Size of rangoli shall not exceed more than 4×4 sq.feet.
- Participants are required to bring their own materials.
- Participants will not be allowed to bring Rangoli designs or reference material along with them.
- Rangoli must be made in the specified area.
- Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited during the competition.
- Time limit is 1 hour.
- Participants can use filter, chalk, glitter powder and rangoli colours.
- No spot entries will be obliged.
- Judge's decision will be final.
